Subject: Use of Teachers of the Speech and Hearing Handicapped, as Independent
Contractors

Section 4410 of the Education Law requires municipalities appropriately qualified individuals who provide occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech pathology, medical services by individuals who provide speech and language situations.

Related services are to be provided according to the present child individualized education program. Allowable sites include: an approved or licensed head start program, the work site of the provider, a hospital, a State facility or a child care location.

Section 8202 of the Education Law requires that language pathology, licensed, or speech to practice under Article 159 of the Education Law. Section 8207(2) provides an exemption for persons employed by the Federal, State or a local elementary or secondary school to perform the duties and hearing handicapped or teachers.
