

3. Select "Computer" or "Paper" format for the operational tests.

In Spring 2025, students in Grades 4, 5, 6 and 8 will be required to take the operational ELA, mathematics, and science tests via CBT. Grades 3 and 7 may also participate in CBT; schools will still be able to select computer or paper for these grades in the drop-down menus. The default is computer for Grades 4, 5, 6 and 8. Schools will not be able to select paper for Grades 4, 5, 6 and 8 for ELA, mathematics, or science in the drop-down menus. Enter the number of students to be tested, whether computer or paper.




4. Request "Test Read" copies.

5. Request alternate-language editions of mathematics or science tests.

When requesting alternate-language editions, schools will also receive the corresponding paper copies of the English editions of the tests to provide as a testing accommodation.
