The SSEC data are collected through an online reporting application, the IRS Data Exchange or "IDEx" that is accessed through the NYSED Application Business Portal and will be available to all school districts, public schools, including charter schools, and BOCES beginning on June 2 8, 2021. Once the 2020-21 school year data collection window closes on July 26, 2021, SSEC data may not be changed.
