## Reporting Deadlines

Category	2020-21 SSEC Deadline	Other Submissions
1. Schools identified as Potentially Persistently Dangerous (PPD) for the 2020-21 school year and notified by letter on December 28, 2020	July 12, 2021	
2. Schools designated as Persistently Dangerous (PD) for the 2020-21 school year	July 12, 2021	July 12, 2021 Parts 5 & 6 of Incident Reduction Plans (IRP)
3. All other public schools (including charter schools), public school districts, and BOCES	July 26, 2021 (School and district level SSEC forms)	

The SSEC data are collected through an online reporting application, the IRS Data Exchange or “IDEx” that is accessed through the [NYSED Application Business Portal](#) and will be available to all school districts, public schools, including charter schools, and BOCES beginning on June 28, 2021. Once the 2020-21 school year data collection window closes on July 26, 2021, SSEC data may not be changed.
